Born in 1960, studied electrical engineering at the Technical University of Munich, Germany, graduated (Dipl.-Ing.) in 1986, gained doctorate (Dr.-Ing.) in 1991.

Career:

From 1986 until 1992 Dr.-Ing. Heinrich Hiesinger was a teaching assistant at the Technical University of Munich. From 1992 until 2000 he held various positions in various countries in the Power Transmission and Distribution Group of Siemens. In 2000 he became President of the Power Transmission and Distribution Group and in 2003 President and CEO of Siemens Building Technologies AG, Zug/Switzerland.

In 2007 he was appointed Member of the Managing Board of Siemens AG. In 2008 he was additionally appointed CEO of the Industry Sector of Siemens and head of the central department Corporate Information Technology.

In October 2010 Dr.-Ing. Hiesinger became Vice Chairman of the Executive Board of ThyssenKrupp AG and together with the Chairman of the Executive Board of ThyssenKrupp AG is responsible for the Communications, Strategy & Technology, Executives Management, Legal & Compliance and Internal Auditing corporate centers, energy and the environment, and the ThyssenKrupp Academy.

The Supervisory Board of ThyssenKrupp AG has appointed Dr.-Ing. Hiesinger Chairman of the Executive Board of ThyssenKrupp AG with effect from the close of the General Stockholders' Meeting on January 21, 2011.
